Ridge Oak Senior Housing Coronavirus Update Sunday, March 22, 2020

Good Morning Ridge Oak Residents, Family Members and Friends -

New Jersey Governor Phil Murphy has ordered all non-essential businesses to close and workers to stay at home and to work remotely if possible. Therefore, effective Monday, March 23rd there will be one (1) Ridge Oak Senior Housing staff person and one (1) maintenance man on-site Monday through Friday 9 am – 5 pm to respond to phone and maintenance emergencies. Please call 908-221-0266 as needed. The community building remains locked. There will be no bus, activities, housekeeping or meal delivery service. Evening and weekend maintenance emergencies will be handled by calling 908-221-0266 and the answering service will contact on-call personnel. Call 911 with any health, police or fire emergencies.

Occupancy staff will work remotely to process as many of the annual income and rent recertifications as possible. Social Services staff will be available remotely with some access to volunteer resources if residents have no one to get needed groceries or prescriptions. If our residents have a family member or friend that can help by picking up and dropping off groceries and prescriptions, we are asking that those resources be utilized first.

PLEASE - if you get a call or e-mail inquiry from Ridge Oak personnel please listen to it, read it and respond to it as indicated! Please stay safe and healthy. Stay indoors. Maintain social distance even when walking outside. Call, text and e-mail your friends and neighbors.
