Applications for a Mail in Ballot are also available from the office or County website. You must be a registered voter to apply for a Mail-In Ballot. Once you apply for a Mail-In Ballot, you will not be permitted to vote by machine at your polling place in the same election. A voter may apply for a Mail-In Ballot by mail up to 7 days prior to the election. Applications are due by May 29th. Voters also now have an option of automatically receiving a Mail-In Ballot for each General Election.

**Pets must be** registered at the office and a \$300 pet registration fee must be paid whether you pay \$300 up-front or pay \$50 initially and \$10 each month until you’ve paid the \$300. Proof of inoculations for dogs and cats will be required annually for tenant pets in accordance with state and local laws.

All pets owned or visiting a resident at Ridge Oak must be leashed when outside of the owner’s apartment. You are required to pick up all



waste, secure it in a plastic bag and dispose of it in a dumpster. You are not allowed to “tether” your dog to a tree or a building. Please walk your pets in perimeter areas to avoid eliminating near buildings.

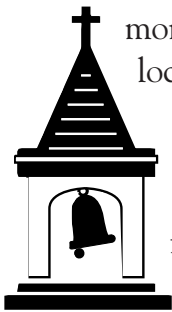
## PERSYS Units

PERSYS (Personal Emergency Response System) is an electronic device that lets you summon help in an emergency. The transmitter is worn around the neck or wrist and sends a signal to the telephone. When emergency help is needed, the PERSYS user presses the button and rescue squad, police and emergency phone numbers are called. Units are monitored by an alarm company. Our units are

owned by Ridge Oak, and residents are billed for monitoring. PERSYS units have truly been “lifesavers” for those who have had an emergency and cannot reach the phone. Maintenance staff is responsible for installing and testing units. If you want to sign up for this medical alert service, call Elaine at the office. Units will be tested Thursday, June 21st. If you will not be home, please leave your pendant out so it can be tested. It is important that all units are working properly in case of emergency.

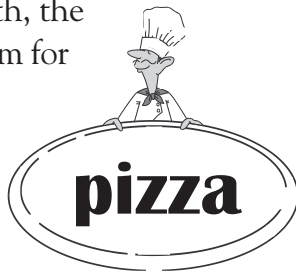

Township Health Department, will talk about healthy eating for our digestive system. Sign-up is required.

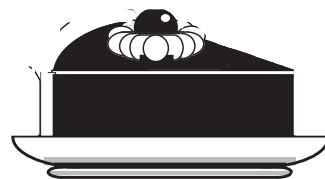
## It's Our War Too

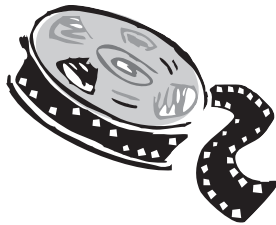
## Let's Celebrate 90


